KUDOS

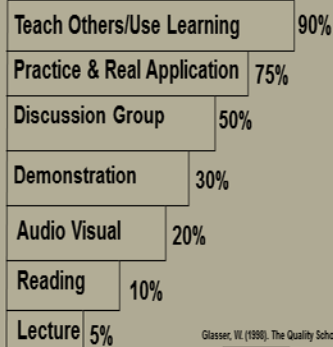
