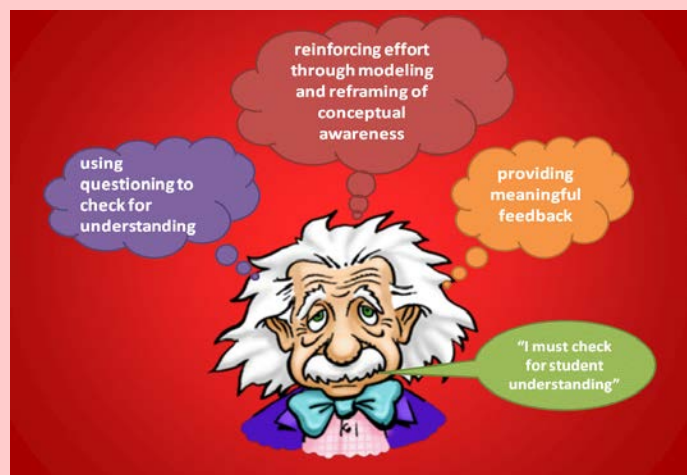
KUDOS
