## **KUDOS**

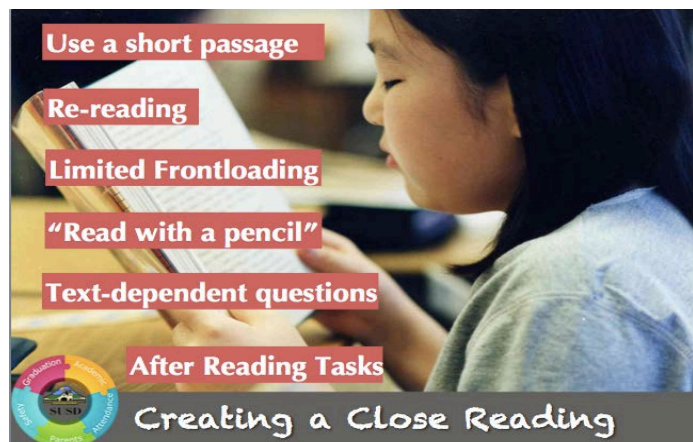
