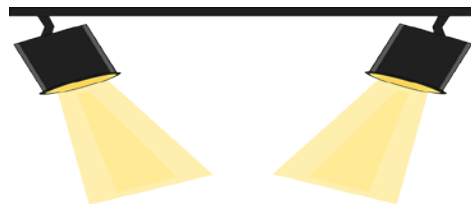

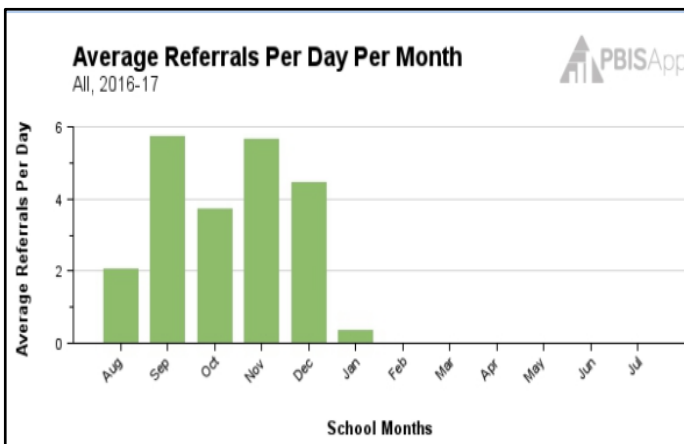

GO PANTHERS!!!!

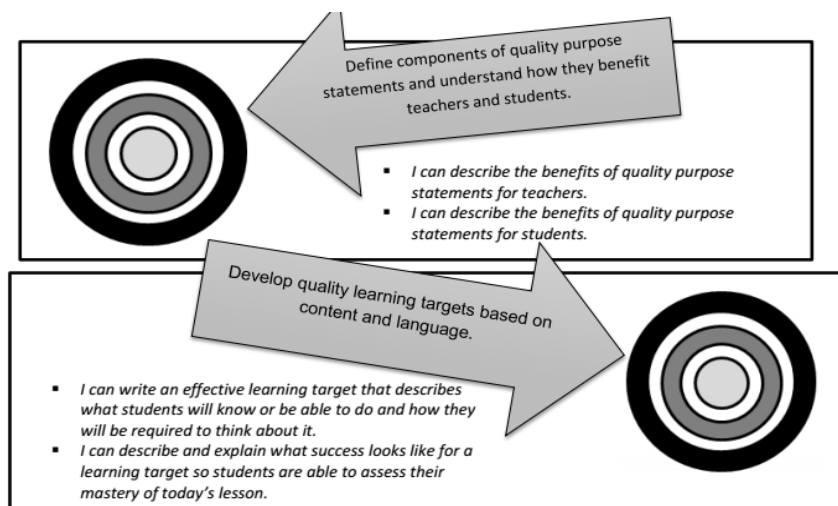
