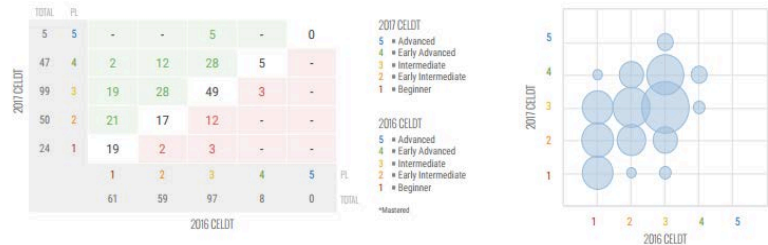

INTERIM TESTING



We will continue with Interim Testing this week. You will be informed if the computer lab and Chrome Books room opens up. This week Mrs. Farrer met with the pupil supervisors and analyzed data. After analysis, it was determined we are having the most referrals at lunch and at the playground. The pupil supervisors committed to catching students doing positive actions and passing out more Paw Bucks. They will also pay close attention to Tier II students. Their plan is to speak the language of our PBIS matrix, and help to teach our students about positive character traits. It is our goal to decrease the amount of referrals by focusing on teaching the students how to keep their hands, feet, and objects to themselves.

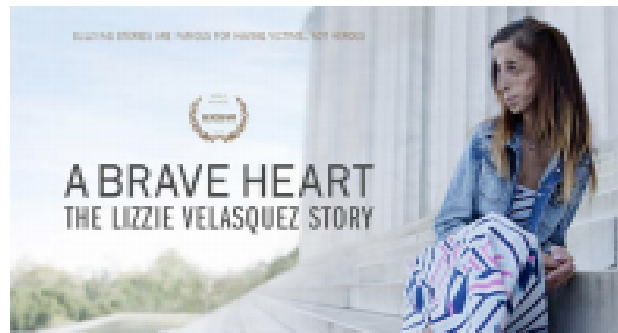
