CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

Instructional rounds were incredibly successful! All district administrators observed San Vicente classrooms and collected evidence of research backed best practices. The overall input showed:

What we did well:

- grade level complex text
- students grouped in collaborative clusters
- lesson purpose was stated
- high student engagement
- low level of classroom management issues
- ELD strategies

Areas to improve on:

- weaving the lesson purpose throughout the lesson
- matching the lesson with the objective
- GRR “we do” strategy
- high student expectations

RTI

Renee, Maria, and Angela have been prepping and getting ready for RTI. They have done an amazing job preparing for our students. Renee has shared what will be done by modeling Making Words, Greek and Latin Roots, and Shared Reading packets with teachers. If you would like a personal demonstration, please let us know. During RTI, teachers will be implementing small group reading instruction. Teachers will have 20 minute blocks to target reading instruction to students at their level. This level of targeted instruction will increase student learning if done correctly. During classroom observations of teacher RTI time, the teacher will be working with a group while the rest of the students are working on ELA extended activities. If you need help with center ideas, please reach out. RTI starts November 14th.

Instructional Focus

Our focus will continue with teacher modeling – informal classroom observations will reflect one of the five ways of teacher modeling.

- Model that which is difficult for students
- Model ways to resolve problems
- Model how you interact with text
- Model through think-aloud
- Model through interactive shared readings
