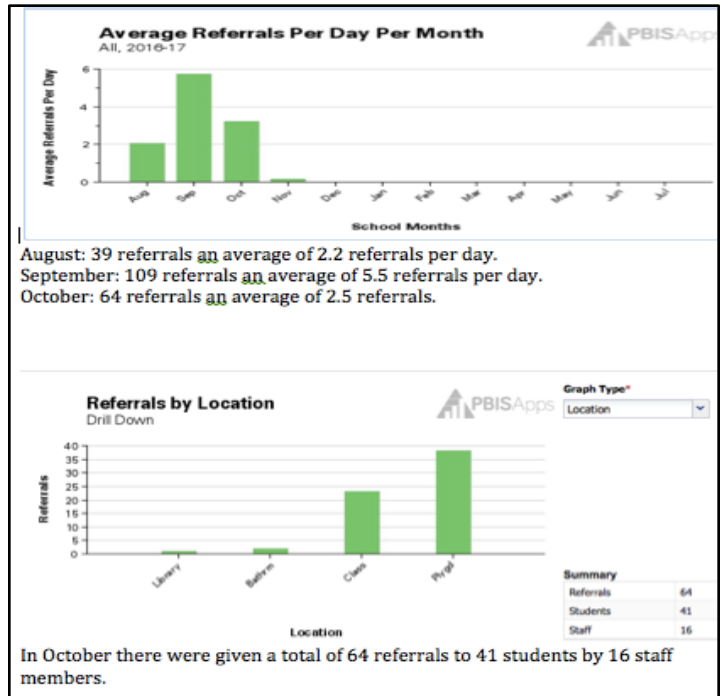
Parent Corner

- Model ways to resolve problems
- Model how you interact with text
- Model through think-aloud
- Model through interactive shared readings
