CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

According to John Hattie, teachers can examine the impact of the learning experience when these four conditions are in place.

1. Lessons should have a clear learning intention. It's hard to determine whether students have learned something if they (and we) aren't sure what it was they were supposed to learn.
2. Lessons should have clear success criteria. The success criteria provide the tools necessary to assess learning.
3. The success criteria indicate what quality looks like. To determine whether or not learning has occurred, students and teacher have to know what success looks like.
4. Students should know where they stand in relation to the criteria for success. When students have no idea if they've done well or not, learning is compromised. Students should understand that learning is on a continuum, that errors are opportunities to learn, and that they can learn more. (Fisher, Frey, & Hattie 2016)
