And again, the teachers' positivity precedes the students' improved performance-strongly suggesting that positivity is causative. –Professor Timothy Sharp

It has provided us with specific data that identifies where these incidents occur, how frequent it occurs, time of day and countless other information. I, along with the PBIS Team have noticed an increase of aggression out on the playground. Please speak with your students prior to them leaving for morning, lunch and noon recess on the importance of keeping their hands, feet and objects to themselves. Teach them to walk away and tell a supervisor or to take a deep breath and consider the consequences. Together we can teach the students the value of thinking before they react. Special thanks to Aurora Ortega for inputting all of the referrals into SWIS. We are looking into a referral system via Google Doc's. The PBIS Team will meet to discuss this possible form and we will let you know the outcome before the month of March.
