CLOSE READING for Literature

First Read: Get the Gist

- When and where does the story take place?
- What do you know about the main characters?
- What are the important events in the story?
- Can you retell the story in your own words?

Second Read: Dig a Little Deeper

- From what point of view is the story being told?
- What interesting words and phrases were used?
- How is dialogue used to tell the story?
- How is the story structured?
- What genre or type of literature is this?

Third Read: Put it all Together

- What inferences can you make?
- What is the theme or message of the story?
- How does it relate to other stories you've read?
- How does this story relate to your life?
