CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION

Instructional Focus

The instructional focus will continue to be on using learning targets and success criteria for all lessons.



Rigorous Reading

This last week, we were trained on the strengths and opportunities of independent learning. We had time to compare and contrast independent reading with SSR including differences in purpose, book selection, accountability, and the role of students and teacher. We also learned key points of having students respond during independent reading. Finally, we learned about the importance of conferring with students as well as the four elements of an effective conference.

To keep up with our yearlong book study, it is recommended that teachers read Chapter 5 of Rigorous Reading – Access Point Four – An Independent Reading Staircase.

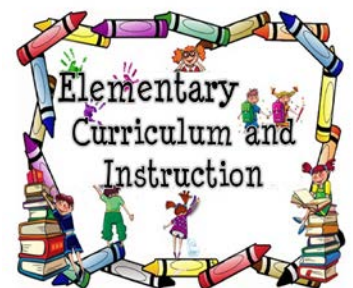

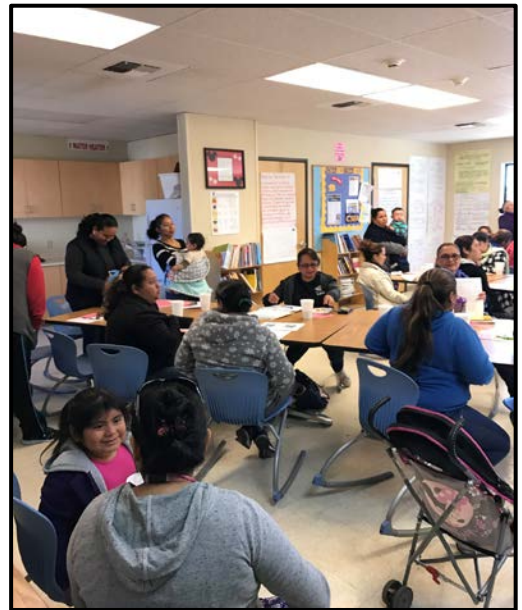
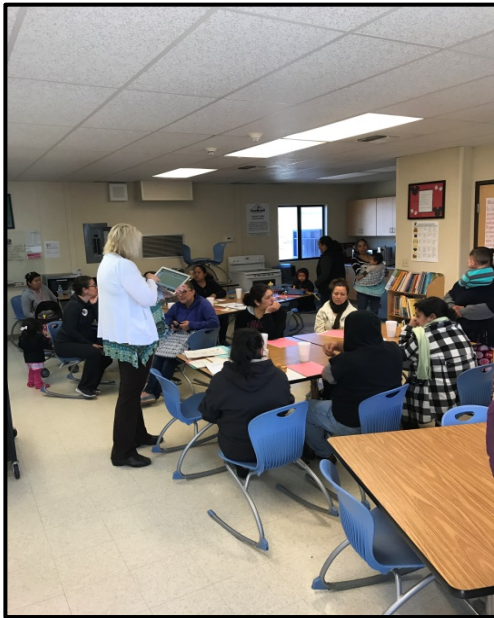
