CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

Mrs. Sandoval did an amazing job teaching ELD this week. Mrs. Sandoval had her anchor chart with sentence frames ready for students to refer to. She had her lesson objective posted and it matched her lesson. To frontload vocabulary, she used vocabulary cards under the document camera for all to see and practice. She continued to wrap back to the learning target throughout the lesson. She used non-fiction text to explore text evidence. Her students were highly aware that they were learning to use text evidence to support their thoughts. Mrs. Sandoval paced her lesson perfectly. She was able to remind students what they learned and ask for an exit ticket as a formative assessment before students switched back to their original classes. Well done Mrs. Sandoval!



This week we will continue to focus on using learning targets and success criteria for all lessons. Every lesson should have a written objective, a stated purpose, wrapping back to the learning, and success criteria. Students need to know what success looks like in order to complete the lesson.

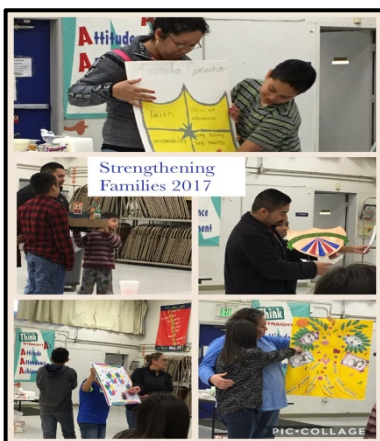
