Instructional Focus

The instructional focus will continue to be on using learning targets and success criteria for all lessons.



RTI

We will continue to tighten up our RTI system. Informal walkthroughs will focus on the success criteria for RTI.

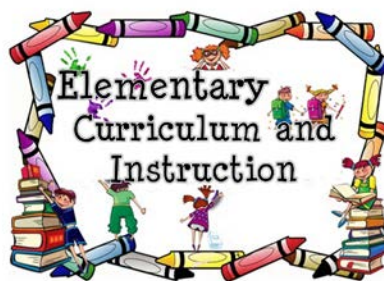
Success Criteria for RTI

- Using reading logs for organizational purposes
- Small groups during 40 minute RTI blocks - teacher working with students at their level - teacher seeing every student at least once during a week
- Using Guided Reading Practices and Close Reading strategies when reading passages
- Learning target and success criteria - do the students know what they are learning? Do the students know what success looks like? Do the learning targets wrap around the CCSS? Do the students know that the learning target is moving them to becoming grade-level proficient based on the CCSS?
- Blended learning - all literacy based - not busy work, but meaningful work
- 3 components of RTI - comprehension, fluency, and vocabulary

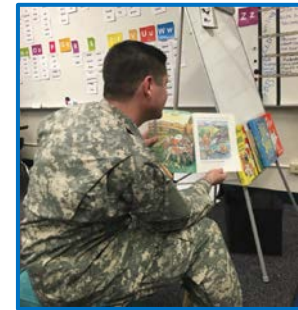
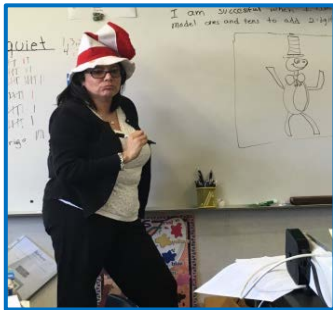
