
# KUDOS

# SBAC

SBAC testing is just around the corner. All snacks have been ordered and are ready to go. I would like to remind you that our next staff meeting will be centered around SBAC, so please make sure not to miss this important meeting. Here are a few SBAC tips:

- 1. <u>Review the answers</u>: Once a student has reached the end of the test, the student can review the answers before submitting. Most students are reluctant to do this because they are exhausted. But do encourage them to do so by first taking a short 5-minute break, then go back and review the answers before submitting.
- 2. <u>Take stretch breaks:</u> No chair is comfortable enough to sit in for 1 hour! I periodically stopped the students to take stretch breaks to get the blood circulating again.
- 3. <u>Use the universal tools:</u> the SBAC has many tools for the students to use such as, highlighting, notepad, mark for review, pop up glossary, etc. Teach your students how to use them.
