CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

Mrs. Esparza did a fantastic job using learning targets and success criteria in her 2nd grade class. The students were learning about prefixes. The students knew they were successful when they could spell and use prefixes correctly in their writing. Mrs. Esparza has a room that is full of current student work, anchor charts that represent current learning, and a learning matrix that is filled out with a pathway for success for students. Mrs. Esparza's data shows her students are growing tremendously.

This week we will continue to focus on using learning targets and success criteria for all lessons. Every lesson should have a written objective, a stated purpose, wrapping back to the learning, and success criteria. Students need to know what success looks like in order to complete the lesson.

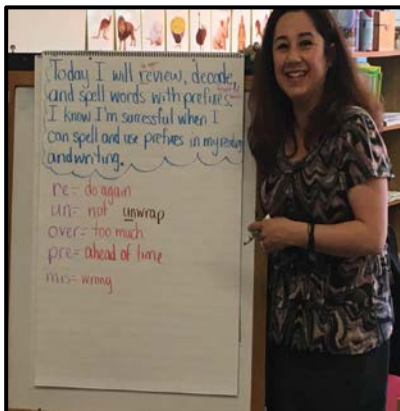
