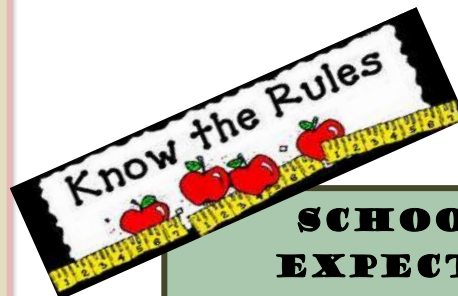
THINK-PAIR-SHARE
