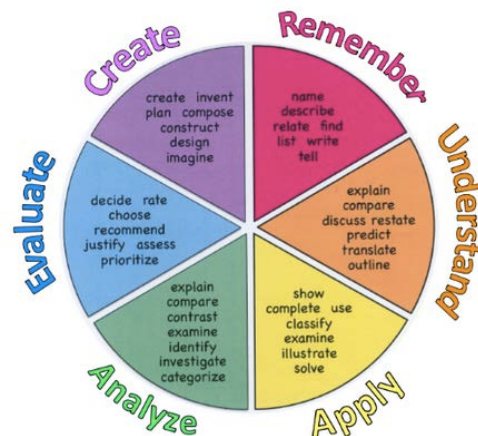
KUDOS

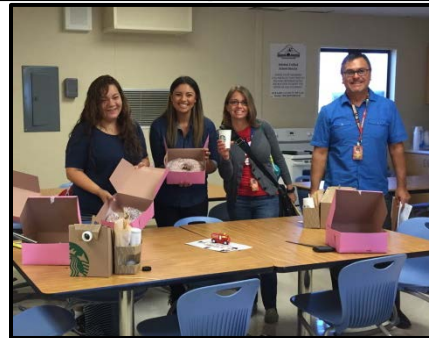
REMINDERS
