#### Why use manipulatives?

Research indicates that lessons using manipulatives are more likely to help children achieve mathematically than lessons without manipulatives (Sowell 1989). This is because students often struggle to relate to concepts and make sense of abstract ideas without some type of first-hand experiences with them. Manipulative use gives students hands on experiences and support learning by creating physical models that become mental modes for concepts and processes (Kennedy, Tipps, and Johnson 2008). So grab those manipulatives and let the fun begin.
