Write a story for the mathematical equation.

DeJuan exercises $\frac{1}{2}$ hour a day for 4 days. How many total hours does he exercise?
Think what makes sense.
- 3 Construct viable arguments and critique the reasoning of others.**
Talk and explain.
- 4 Model with mathematics.**
Show your thinking.
- 5 Use appropriate tools strategically.**
Use the right tools.
- 6 Attend to precision.**
Check your work.
- 7 Look for and make use of structure.**

- 8 Look for and express regularity in repeated reasoning.**
