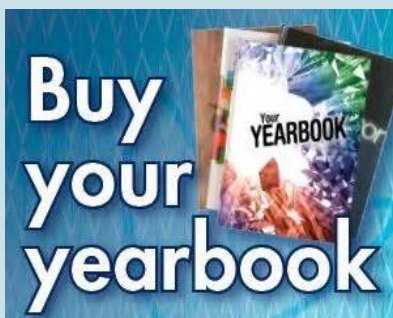
## Literacy Night
